

LEARNING BY DOING! MATHEMATICS LABORATORY














'Mathematics is the most beautiful and most powerful creation of the human spirit!

It helps the students learn and explore mathematics concepts and verify mathematical facts using multiple teaching and learning aids, consisting of technology applications, measuring instruments, tables, and charts etc. It also enables the teachers to demonstrate, explain and reinforce abstract mathematical ideas by using concrete objects, models, charts, graphs, pictures, posters etc. Students learn to understand their world in terms of numbers and shapes. It also encourages the students to think, discuss among themselves as well as with the teacher, and assimilate concepts. The Mathematics Laboratory is a breakthrough initiative to make the present curriculum simpler and interesting, thereby bring back the joy of learning Mathematics.



Social Science Laboratory






